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Good morning Noelle, Thank you for your email. Unfortunately this amendment is not acceptable. I provided the appropriate amendment. One that did not make reference to me at all. The motion to eliminate the requirement for road access agreements was a conversation that I brought forward to council.. Much the same as any issue or conversation any councillor is entitled to bring forward. In my experience with you I have never seen you isolate or insinuate that one councillor or a single member of the public was responsible for the persuasion of all council members. I brought forward an issue of concern, it was openly discussed by ALL councillors. EVERY councillor spoke and a motion was passed. I do believe the motion was passed unanimously, to eliminate the need for Road access agreements. Singling out one individual one councilor is not how the Township has ever worked in the past. A council decision is a council decision regardless of who brings it forward, who agrees or disagrees, once passed is solely a decision of Council and to be supported and respected by all.

If you wish to add: The council at the time were presented concerns (IT IS IRRELEVANT WHO PRESENTED THE CONCERNS) that lead to further discussion and the passing of a motion # to eliminate road accesses agreements and that section 3.4 zoning by-law be reviewed and appropriately revised. I would accept that.

I do have an email from you stating that it would be fairly easy to write the by-law to enact Councils direction, But you were never told to write that by-law. You have referred to my IC report in discussion with members of the public deflecting their concerns and again making it sound like I personally unduly influenced my fellow councillors, and was found guilty by the IC commissioner. Tony did not find me guilty of unduly influencing my fellow councillors. I followed proper procedure, brought my concerns forward, council discussed it and a motion was passed. I am still really struggling to understand why Township staff are choosing to use me in this way. Was I really that hard to work with? I would really like to put this behind me and move on with my life. But I will not be accused of something I did not do. Please advise.
